



## GOOD GOVERNANCE




 Communicate the effectiveness of NGO activities to increase citizens' trust and thus their engagement.




#### Prioritize anti-corruption initiatives, especially among doctors and judges/prosecutors. Building trust in courts could strengthen feeling of justice and safety.

Perceived corruption is still very high despite the high levels of tolerance to corruption. 47 % of Mariupol respondents believe that accepting small amounts of money or taking gifts for performing official functions is not corruption



LOCALITY SATISFACTION (in terms of jobs, leisure activities and raising children)




